Location

ESCAPE 21 will be held in Chalkidiki, Greece. Chalkidiki is a three-pronged peninsula, located in Northern Greece, roughly in the center of Macedonia. To the North it shares borders with the prefecture of Thessaloniki. To the South, East and West Chalkidiki juts into the Aegean Sea. Due to the area's geomorphology, Chalkidiki has the longest stretch of coastline in mainland Greece, estimated to be more than 500 km of sandy beaches and attractive bays. To the north of the coastal region the country becomes mountainous. The whole region is heavily wooded with pines and olive trees, while inland there are vineyards and fertile farmlands.

The climate in Chalkidiki is generally mild with limited rainfall whilst sunshine and warm summers are well known. It enjoys over 300 days of sunshine on average annually.

Hotel Meliton, Porto Carras Grand Resort: The hotel is located in a hidden paradise in Northern Greece, on the western coast of Sithonia, Chalkidiki's central peninsula, 120 km from Thessaloniki.
